



School Introduction:

Fukiai High School in Kobe city, Japan is a 71-year-old, co-educational, public high school. There are about 840 students (10th ~12th graders; 15 years old~18 years old) studying in a very friendly atmosphere. Our school is located in the central part of Kobe. In January 1995, the Great Hanshin Awaji Earthquake attacked Kobe and three Fukiai students were killed then. We think that it is our duty to tell the importance of the preparedness of natural disasters.

Fukiai High School has both the regular course and the international course. Students in the regular course are required to take Japanese, history, social studies, math, science, health and PE, art English, home economics and informational technology lessons, etc. Additionally, students in the international course have a special curriculum which focuses on cross cultural-understanding and international relations. We have six sister school in Sweden, Australia, USA, and Taiwan. Also, we participate in several international projects, such as NDYS and UNESCO ASPNet School.

Safety Map Introduction - 1

We made our safety map on Google Maps. The reason why we decided to make it on the Internet is that we thought it's more useful for the people who have access to the Internet, and for spreading our activity over many other areas.

To tell the process of making this map, we came up with the idea of expanding the area of the safety map our seniors had made, at first. Then we gathered some community safety maps and rewrote the latest information by walking around those areas because most of those maps were made about 10 years ago. We also took some pictures to make the map clearer. After that, we uploaded the information on Google Maps. We typed it both in Japanese and in English. Finally, we made the map able to be searched by the words "葺合" or "Fukiai."
