



NDYS Tree Planting Event collaboration with ENO

21st of September 2005

PREPARATIONS

1. Find a tree plant (choose an indigenous one that is typical for your climate and is one of dominant tree species in your region. Choose a suitable place for tree and dig the hole in advance
2. In your class, choose a student who will actually plant this tree.
3. Invite a person outside your school to plant tree together with you
4. In your class, choose a student who will have a short speech (see below)
5. In your class, choose students who will take 2-3 photos (preferably digital) about this occasion.
6. Invite other school and local decision-makers to join this event, probably one of them could have a short speech for this occasion.
7. At your school, make a map of world with countries involved in tree planting, see here: <http://eno.joensuu.fi/treemapschedule2005.htm>
8. In the event, add to your speech, **in which countries trees have been planted before you** and in which countries **they are doing it the same time with you!** See info here: <http://eno.joensuu.fi/treemapschedule2005.htm>
9. Get local media involved (see the draft for them below)

TREE PLANTING EVENT

Date: Tuesday, 21st of September

Time: at 12.00-12.30 your local time

1. Gather around the tree plant
2. A student makes his/her speech
3. A student plants this tree together with an old person (while one takes photos, remember to take one photon only about tree, as close as possible)
4. Students measure the height of tree (in millimetres)
5. Optionally another speech by local decision-makers.
6. Other optional program (songs, poems etc.)
7. Gather for a group photo, where students and audience are around the tree plant so that we can see BOTH the tree plant AND all the audience
8. **IMPORTANT: After** the event, enter the digital photos and other information to **ENO TREE DATABASE** with your comments! ENO schools can edit them afterwards. <http://eno.joensuu.fi/treedatabase.htm>
9. After event, share your comments in the **SPECIAL CHAT ROOM!**

A SPEECH FOR THE OCCASION

Our environment is important for us. Not only locally but also globally around the world. Our school is a member of a programme called NDYS.

NDYS-Natural Disaster Youth Summit. NDYS is a global school network for awareness of natural disasters and sustainable development where currently students, 20 school classes in 15 countries study about the mechanism of natural disasters, mental care, how we can survive, help each others, prevent disasters and support sustainable development locally and globally. We are proud and happy to be one of them.

Today is the International Peace day and anniversary of Earth quake of Taiwan in 1999. We plant this tree today, at 12.00 local time, together with our friends in the North, South, East and West collaborating with ENO-Environmental Online project.

Our school takes part to NDYS-Natural Disaster Youth Summit. This is one of the iEARN-International Education and Resource Network projects. NDYS project is a global school network for Disaster Management Education where currently __ schools in 15 countries study natural disasters and environmental issues from 1st of September till the end of March 2006 on a weekly basis. After creating a Global Disaster Safety Map, we will have a Youth Summit in Taiwan from 7th to 8th of January in 2006.

September 21st is the commemorative day of the Earthquake in Taiwan and also the International Day of Peace.
