



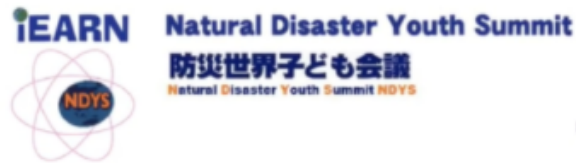

In honor of the Americans with Disabilities Act 30th Anniversary, the YES (Youth Exchange and Study) team at iEARN-USA hosted a series of virtual events centered around Netflix's "Crip Camp" from August 17th-21st. The film narrates the story of youth at a disability camp who became activists for the disability rights movement and fought for accessibility legislation. 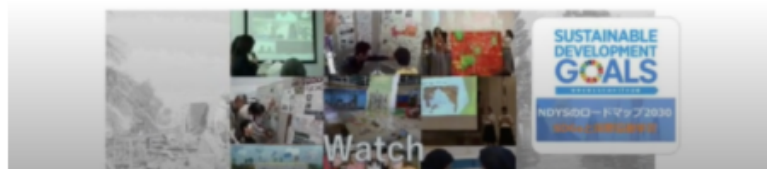

iEARN-Japan hosted the Natural Disaster Youth Summit 2020, or 'NDYS2020 in Yokkaichi,' virtually on August 23rd. The Summit was a great success, with more than 100 students and teachers from ten countries participating. The event was the final phase of the year-round project and provided participants the opportunity to present their important work. Despite the challenges of not being able to gather physically as planned in Niigata, Japan, and even for students from the same school to come together in person, due to COVID-19, six groups from six countries gave oral presentations and conducted musical performances. At the event, participants together proclaimed the following NDYS 2020 declaration:
