OUR PHOTO EXHIBITION ABOUT NDYS TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO 2008

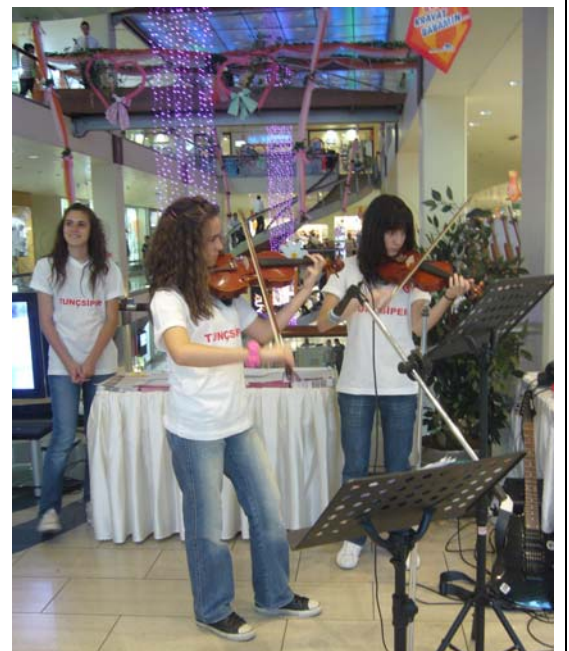
