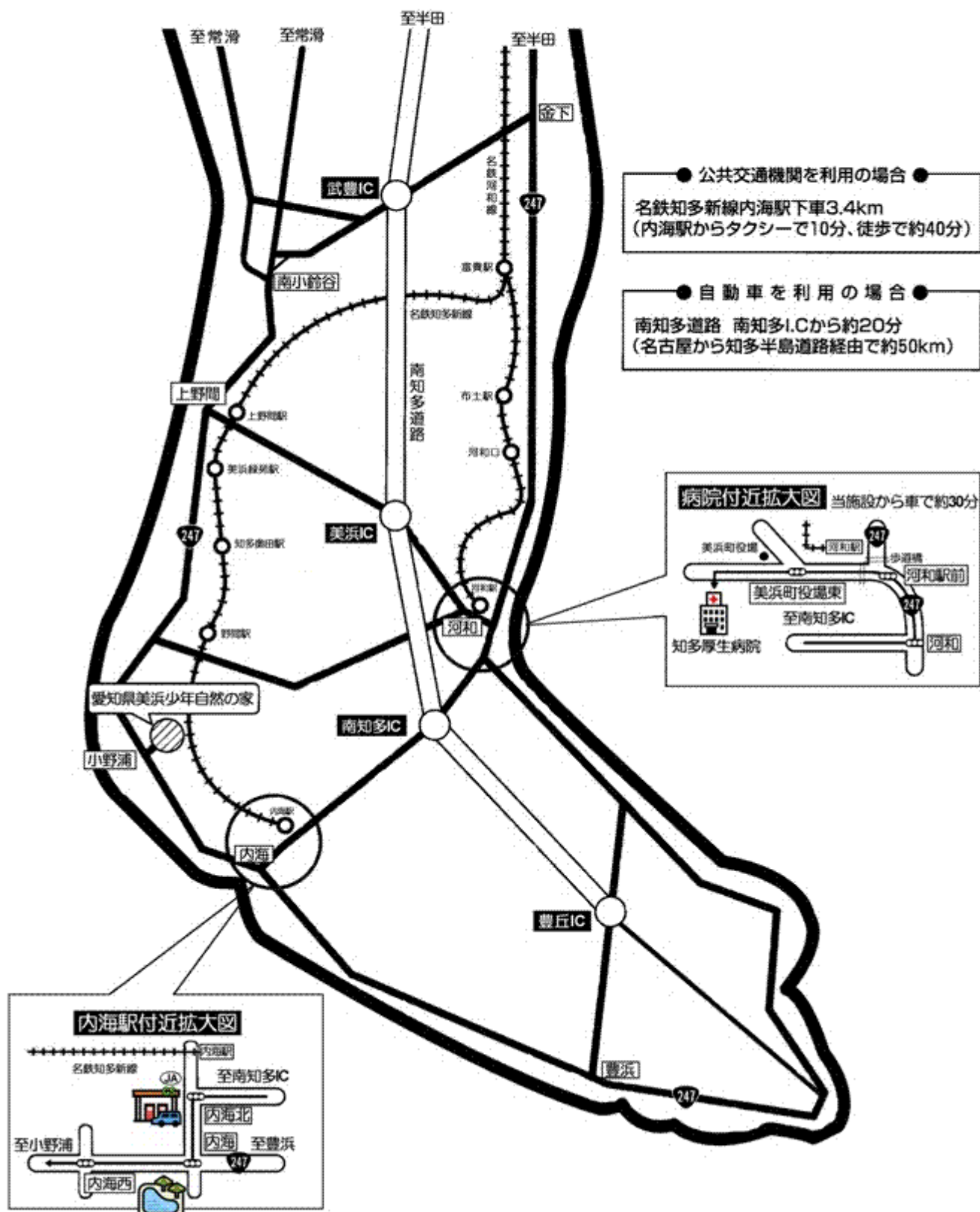

4 Required belongings & clothes

The venue is on a hill. The sea with beaches is nearby.

It may still be cold at the beginning of May.

In May, Mihama's average temperature is a maximum of 23 degrees centigrade and a minimum of 11 degrees centigrade.

Please bring a warm jacket.

There will be a campfire on the night on May 3rd.

Please wear fire-resistant clothing in case of sparks.

Please prepare suitable clothing for yourself.

On the night of May 3, a picture will be painted on a big sheet by everyone together.

Please prepare one set of clothing which may become dirty with paint.

Basic size of the picture : 5 feet by 12 feet (152cm by 366cm)



Cooking may be done in the field campsite.

Please prepare suitable clothes for cooking at the campsite.

If the weather is good on May 4th, a mold of the disaster prevention map will be made in the sand.

Please prepare suitable dress for use in the sand.

On May 4th, there will be a party where you will introduce your countries.

Please bring the traditional clothes of your country.

Japanese participants are expected to bring a kimono.

There will be a cooking festival on this day.

Participants who are good at cooking need to prepare seasoning.

Foods which can be prepared in Japan, such as fresh vegetables, will be prepared in Japan.
